Visas

All visitors must have valid passports and a return or onward ticket. Visas are not required of US, Canadian or British Citizens and most European nationals, but there are odd exceptions so please check with your travel agent. Duty free allowances for personal items include: one quart in total wines and spirits, half-pound tobacco or 50 cigars or 200 cigarettes. No restrictions on the amount of money that can be brought in. Restricted items are fruits, vegetables, meat, soil, illegal drugs, firearms and ammunition.

Climate

The dry season runs from January to May. In July, the wettest month, rain falls for an average of 26 days, while in April, the driest month, it averages only six days. In January the average daily high temperature is 29°C (85°F), while the nightly low is 22°C (72°F). In July the average high is 30°C (86°F), while the nightly low is 24°C (76°F).



Travelling

The base is located in Port Louis Marina on Grenada. Maurice Bishop International Airport is only five miles from the marina and has direct flights to many US cities. The following airlines run scheduled flights to Grenada: British Airways, Virgin Atlantic, American Airlines, LIAT, Caribbean Airlines, SVG Airlines, Conviasa, Delta, Air Canada.
