Modern Sailing COVID-19 Boat Sanitation Protocol

- Sailing is a hands-on activity. To ensure thorough sanitation of boats, the Modern Sailing Fleet Team have implemented a sanitation protocol.
- Personal protective equipment detailed below will be utilized by our Fleet Staff as they undergo sanitation procedures.
- Boats will be thoroughly sanitized the day after use and opened to allow fresh air to flow through.
- Before and between charter uses, we will follow this step-by-step protocol:

✓ EXTERIOR SCRUB

- Scrub exterior surfaces with boat soap and water, with special attention to the cockpit.
 Scrubbing of cockpit table, winches, rope clutches, cleats, helm, and binnacle.
- Scrubbing of stations and handrails around the entry point and stern pulpit.

✓ INTERIOR SURFACE DISINFECTION

- **Clean all hard surfaces**. Applying generous amounts of multi-surface cleanser, methodically spray all hard surfaces from top to bottom. Do not wipe down; spray first, then come back to the beginning and wipe down. Follow this order to ensure no area is overlooked:
- V-berth: walls, light switches, flat surfaces, cabinet doors and latches, hatches, and floor.
- Salon: Bulkhead, compression post, salon table (including folding sides and underside), walls, light switches, storage spaces, nav table, cabinet doors and latches, hatches, and floor.
- **Galley:** Refrigerator, microwave, stove, sink, walls, light switches, storage spaces, cabinet doors and latches, hatches, and floor.
- **Head:** Remove/stow trash bin and toilet paper. Using generous amounts of multi-surface cleanser, methodically spray and wipe down all hard surfaces from top to bottom. Use shower nozzle to hose down walls, toilet, sink, and all other hard surfaces. Drain the head. Open hatches to dry if weather permits.
- Aft Cabins: walls, light switches, flat surfaces, cabinet doors and latches, hatches, and floor.
- Go back to V-berth and wipe multi-surface off.
- **Disinfect soft surfaces**. Spray mattress and cushions with hotel-grade disinfectant spray.

ADDITIONAL DISINFECTION OF COMMON TOUCH POINTS

• **Disinfect all common touch points.** Apply Professional Lysol and wipe down all touch points: grab rails, latches, handles, light switches, equipment panels, faucets, charter equipment (winch handles, air horn, etc.), helm, winches, rope clutches, and faucets.
